




The hotel has a total of (5) handicapped rooms and one is already booked for a person attending the meeting. So there are only (4) left.

# TRANSPORTATION



You will again be responsible for travel to get to Chicago and the hotel booking and payment; but we will pick up at the airport; drop you off and pick you up at the hotel and provide all ground transportation for the meeting. We will also provide food. You just have to get here that Friday night (we will serve a late supper at the hotel) and we will provide food through the Sunday afternoon.

These doctors are amazing to give us their weekend. Steve Finkel will be coordinating transportation for attendees.

You will get transportation to and from the airport. We will try to coordinate group shuttles in respect to various flight arrivals and departures. However, If you chose to fly to Chicago and wish to take a your own taxi to and/or from the airport, the hotel uses American Taxi Dispatch for their clients' airport needs. The fare from O'hare to the hotel runs \$25.00 one-way. From Midway it is about \$40.00 with an additional \$2.00 per person. You may call and reserve a taxi before you arrive to secure a flat rate. To contact American Taxi Dispatch simply call 847-259-0276 or click into [www.americantaxi.com](http://www.americantaxi.com) to make reservations. If you choose to take a city taxi from the cab stand at the airport, the fares from O'hare have been \$40.00-\$60.00 and \$80.00 from Midway Airport to the hotel. These are city taxis and are metered. They do not run on a flat rate.
